

LEWES BPW UPDATES

Highland Acres

With the recent annexation into the city, the Lewes BPW will now be providing water and sewer services to the residents of Highland Acres. Our engineers have completed the design of the water and sewer mains and are working toward the completion of individual hook-ups for the residents.

Lewes BPW Water Department - Savannah Road Project

Our Water Department has completed the tying in of the commercial and residential properties on Savannah Road to the 12" water main. Currently, they are in the process of turning off and/or abandoning the valves to the old 4"-6" water lines in the road. If you should experience an outage of service, please contact our office to report.

The contractor is continuing with the restoration of road patches, sidewalks and curbs on Savannah Road, and Del-Dot will be paving the road sometime after September 15, 2015.

Lewes BPW Electric Department

The Electric Department is continuing to change out the old manual electric meters to the new ERT meters. This upgrade will ensure the reduction of man hours, improve accuracy and enable the readings to be done without entering the property. You may experience a temporary outage for a brief minute or two when this occurs.

Showfield Development

Showfield is a planned unit development (PUD) of 250+ homes which will be located south of Freeman Highway and west of the canal. The Lewes BPW will be providing water service to the development with no interruption of service to any surrounding areas.
