A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEWES, ELIMINATING CERTAIN IMPACT FEES FOR THE ADDITION OF RESIDENTIAL IRRIGATION METERS

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works exists so that current and future customers have availability and accessibility to safe, reliable and affordable water and other public services; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works provides these services for life sustaining use while being environmental stewards; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.4 of the Charter of the Board of Public Works, being Chapter 10, Volume 77, Laws of Delaware as amended, the Board of Public Works has the authority to fix impact fees for the utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works desires that there be an effective way for its customers to exclude water used for irrigation from the calculation of sewer charges.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes, in session met, a quorum pertaining at all times thereto, that the Board of Public Works eliminate the collection of impact fees for the installation of residential irrigation meters when such meters are installed as a connection to the existing lateral serving the residence requesting the irrigation meter effective July 9, 2010 at 12:01am.
